

County matches RAC funding for dust abatement

Posted Nov. 23, 2009—Flathead County Public Works Director Dave Prunty announced that the county will take advantage of their dust cost share program to match \$10,250 of Resource Advisory Committee (RAC) funding for dust abatement on the North Fork road. The county plans to use these funds to apply magnesium chloride between June 15th and June 30th to 1.5 miles of the road north of Camas, 1 mile north of Coal Creek and 1.5 miles north of Hay Creek. The county will use this opportunity to evaluate how well the magnesium chloride planned for this effort performs with the new gravel (with bentonite added) as opposed to those sections that will not be treated.
