

Sondreson Hall Use Policy for Community Events

Approved by the NFLA Board of Directors in May 2011

Purpose

Consistent with our designation as a 501 (c)(4), Sondreson Hall may be used free of charge for all events that are open to the entire community as long as there is a sponsor who is a member of the NFLA. The NFLA is tax-exempt and operates primarily to further the common good and general welfare of the community as a whole. It cannot be operated for the benefit of private interests.

Criteria

All NFLA members who request to use the hall for free must meet the criteria below:

1. The sponsor of the event must be a landowner and a member of NFLA.
2. The event must be open to the entire community.
3. The rental request must be submitted two weeks prior to the date.

Procedures

The request must be made through the NFLA Board through the designated person as identified on the NFLA website. The Board is the only entity that can deny a request.

After approval, the request will be posted on the NFLA website, the Hall, and if in advance, in the Spring Newsletter.

Once approved, the sponsor must follow the host duties outlined in the rental policy.
